Announcing “*The March of Remembrance*” for Christians on Yom HaShoa April 21, 2009

In April of 2007, TOS Church of Tuebingen, Germany set off on a prayer walk called “**The March of Life**” across southern Germany retracing the paths of the death marches of 1945 to Dachau in order to break the silence of indifference across the Schwabian Alps to Bavaria. So many were touched by this symbolic gesture that in August of 2008 members of over 30 east German churches joined together with TOS Church for a “**March of Life II**” prayer walk covering the entire region formerly known as East Germany. in the shape of a Star of David (full documentation at marchoflife.org)

Many Christians and Messianic Jews from America, Europe, and Israel joined their German friends on these marathon prayer walks. This extremely positive intercessory act has now come to America in the form of “*The March of Remembrance*”

On April 21, 2009 at 10 AM we will gather at the Dallas Holocaust Museum for a prayer walk to the Dallas City Hall in honor of Yom HaShoah (Day of Remembrance for the Holocaust). At Dallas City Hall, four Holocaust survivors will give brief testimonies before lighting six candles in honor of six million Jews who died under Nazi genocide.

All are invited to attend or participate in this solemn assembly by meeting at The Holocaust Museum at 211 N. Record Street in downtown Dallas at 10 AM on Tuesday morning, April 21, 2009. We will visit the museum and then walk for a half-mile to the Dallas City Hall together.

Speakers at City Hall include: William & Rosalie Schiff from Dallas TX telling their compelling stories of surviving Auschwitz and being saved by Oskar Schindler; Rose Price, survivor of 6 camps before liberation from Dachau; and Peter Loth who was born in Stuttof concentration camp will all speak of finding life after surviving the Nazi death camps. Isaac Levy, son of a survivor from Auschwitz will speak about being the child of a survivor and Pastor Jobst Bittner of Tuebingen Germany will light a candle representing Christians who pray “Never Again!”

Later that day at 7 PM, we will hold another meeting for Survivors and Pastors to speak about the dangers of silent indifference at Hillcrest Church located at 12123 Hillcrest Rd in North Dallas, (972) 392-3992

Christian groups in Cocoa Beach FL/ Miami FL/Gig Harbor WA/Dayton OH/Farmington NM (with other cities being added) are spontaneously laying the groundwork for a much larger event in 2010 as the official launch of the “*March of Remembrance*”
